DISPOSAL OF ABOVE-GRADE LOW-LEVEL RADIOACTIVE WASTE FROM

THE MOLYCORP, WASHINGTON, PA, FACILITY

Dear Mr. Dawes:

I am responding to your letter of September 15, 2000, which informed the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff of your plans to dispose of low-level radioactive waste, currently located in the slag pile, drums, and roll-off boxes, at the Envirocare facility in Clive, Utah. Your letter also included the bases for your conclusions that the planned activities are authorized under the terms and conditions of your license.

Based on the information provided in your letter, we have concluded that the activities as described in your letter do not involve excavation and, therefore are not addressed by conditions 15A and B. We have also reviewed your radiation protection procedures submitted by letter dated August 3, 2000, to meet condition 15 D and they appear acceptable to ensure that the requirements of Part 20 are met. Accordingly, we have concluded that the proposed activities for offsite disposal are authorized by condition 15F. Finally, we note your commitment as described in your September 15, 2000, letter to construct engineered barriers to control runoff and erosion, cover the pile, maintain programs for storm water management and sediment control, and sample both surface water and sediment. Should these plans change, please notify me prior to implementation of any changes.
