1. NOTICE OF REORGANIZATION OF URANIUM RECOVERY PROGRAM STAFF WITHIN THE OFFICE OF NUCLEAR MATERIAL SAFETY AND SAFEGUARDS

2. GUIDANCE FOR SUBMITTAL OF FUTURE LICENSEE AND STAKEHOLDER CORRESPONDENCE TO NRC

The purpose of this letter is to inform all Uranium Recovery Program licensees and stakeholders of a reorganization of Uranium Recovery Program staff within the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards. Effective June 4, 2000, responsibility for the Uranium Recovery Program and designated staff were reassigned to the Fuel Cycle Licensing Branch in the Division of Fuel Cycle Safety and Safeguards within the Office of Nuclear Material Safety and Safeguards. The assigned Chief of the Fuel Cycle Licensing Branch is Philip Ting. The current list of assigned NRC Points of Contact/Project Managers for Uranium Recovery Program licensees, including telephone numbers and e-mail addresses, is provided in the attachment to this letter.
