Fitness For Duty Six Month Report July 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000

Management Action:

Management actions to enhance the Fitness For Duty Program during this reporting period:

 Management continued to challenge all four of Entergy's sites (ANO, Waterford-3, RBS and GGNS) to standardize common practices and processes. Working groups, comprised of representatives from each site, have been established to accomplish these tasks.

Fitness For Duty Initiatives Taken:

- There were no individuals in the GGNS follow-up program during this reporting period.
- Random Testing Rate during this period was 28.7%. Yearly Random testing rate is 50.0%. GGNS yearly Random testing rate for 2000 was 53.0%.

Effective Evaluation:

An audit of the Fitness for Duty Program was conducted by the Site Quality
Assurance Organization during this report period. The audit team concluded,
"Fitness for Duty met all standard requirements".

Non-Reportable Events:

Blind Performance sample shipped to DHHS Certified Lab tested negative for THC. This sample should have tested positive for THC based on supplier certification documents. The DHHS Certified Lab rechecked process and found no problems. GC/MS testing verified the specimen contained 10.2ng/ml for THC. The sample that remained in Fitness for Duty at GGNS was shipped to another DHHS Certified Lab. The results were negative at 6.7ng/ml at limit of detection. Investigative actions determined that the blind specimen, which was within two weeks of it's expiration date, had deteriorated below the confirmatory level of 15ng/ml before being tested. The condition was documented in the GGNS corrective action program.
