LEGISLATION ON STOCKPILING POTASSIUM IODIDE

Attached for your information is H.R. 783, a bill introduced February 28 by
Representative English (R-PA). This bill is identical to legislation Representative English
introduced last Congress. H.R. 783 directs the Director of the Federal Emergency
Management Agency (FEMA) jointly with the NRC to develop a plan for stockpiling potassium
iodide tablets in areas within a 50-mile radius of a nuclear power plant. The bill has been
referred to the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
