The commission* was briefed by the staff on the status and future options of its reactor operator requalification examination program.

Commissioner Carr emphasized the importance of incorporating lessons learned from the examination program and transmitting feedback to both the Regions and Headquarters.

Commissioner Rogers requested the staff evaluate a fourth option involving an institute other than INPO, (i.e. the National Institute for Certification of Engineering Technologists).
