


The purpose of this modification is to: 1) adjust the fixed price for basic guard services and ordering ceiling for TAS for the initial three contract periods based on actual hours incurred and invoices submitted and paid, 2) adjust slightly the estimated hours in the price schedule for option year three, 3) make an adjustment to the hourly rates in the price schedule for option year three as a result of the execution of new Collective Bargaining Agreement, 4) allot sufficient net funds to cover the total cost of the contract, 5) incorporate a new signed SF 98 into the contract at Section H.3 for the remaining contract periods, 6) delete the second sentence of Section C.12.8. Accordingly, the contract is hereby modified:
