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## SYNOPSIS

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Office of Investigations (OI), Region II, initiated this investigation on September 29, 2000, to determine whether a scientist employed on the Chemistry staff at the Duke Power Energy Corporation McGuire Nuclear Station falsified training records regarding specific on-the-job training and task performance evaluations regarding sampling and chemical additions on several safety-related systems.

Based upon evidence developed during this investigation, OI did not substantiate that the staff scientist willfully falsified the training records.
