### TEST RESULTS

## WCNOC Employees

No WCNOC employees tested positive during this period.

#### Contractors

Three outage contractors tested positive for marijuana and one tested positive for alcohol during pre-access testing. The contractors that tested positive for marijuana were denied access. The contractor that tested positive for alcohol was granted unescorted access and placed in a follow-up program after regulatory and procedural requirements were met.

A contractor that was placed in WCNOC's follow-up program due to historical Fitness-For-Duty concerns, tested positive for alcohol on a follow-up screening. This individual's unescorted access was revoked and the individual was terminated.

#### Fitness-For-Duty Program Changes

To facilitate a request from the Certified Testing Laboratory, WCNOC is now performing split samples. This involves splitting the sample into two bottles. This change occurred during this report period.
