I. SECY-88-163 - ALAB-891: Remanding Coaxial Cable Issue

The Commission, by a 4-0* vote, approved an order addressing ALAB-891 which remanded the Seabrook coaxial cable issue to the Licensing Board. The order directs the Licensing Board to determine whether the Seabrook remanded coaxial cable issues need be resolved before low-power operations.
