V. Ordaz called. She said:

On Thursday, May 20, 1999, we have to give a briefing to G. Holahan and J. Swolinski. Want to keep the group small. Either M. Cheok or G. Kelly will be at the briefing.

G. Holahan wants the technical basis paper before the meeting. We will give it to him tomorrow.

I need to get together with M. Cheok and finish up the MACCS work.

I called M. Cheok. I told him where I was on the MACCS work. He said he would come over at 1:30 today to discuss.

I went to see CT. Not in, so I went to see FE. FE said CT was on AL today. I briefed FE on the upcoming meetings. He said:

If NRR does not want you to present stuff at the briefing for Holahan, that's ok because it is a meeting of NRR staff and their management. It would probably be a good idea for me to be at the briefing to answer any questions that might come up on the MACCS analysis.

If NRR wants MACCS results presented at the public meeting on June 7, then I should be the one to present them. He knows of no reason why someone else should present them.

I called V. Ordaz and told her what my management [FE] said about my participation in the May 20 and June 7 meetings.

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
