Dear Sirs:

Table 1 in Appendix G of Regulatory Guide 10.8 contains Investigational Levels (mrem per calendar quarter) for occupational external doses which initiate review or investigation by the RSO.

This table is also incorporated in Table G-1 in License Guide 10.8 (Revision 2, December 1997), "Guide for the Preparation of Applications for Medical Programs", issued by the Bureau for Radiological Health, New York City Department of Health.

The wording of these three categories and the indicated levels seem to be based on outdated annual dose levels (see NCRP Report No. 33, Appendix B, Table 1, issued February 1, 1968 [out of date]).

The old NCRP table uses the same wording as Table 1, containing the following annual dose limits:

Maximum yearly dose (rem)

 Whole body; head and trunk; active blood-forming organs; lens of eye; or gonads 	5 [with accumulated dose 5(N-18)]
2. Hands and forearms; feet and ankles	75
3. Skin of whole body	30

The Level I and Level II values listed in Table 1 correspond to 2.5% and 7.5%, respectively, of these outdated annual limits.

The current annual dose limits (see 10CFR20.1201; NCRP Report 116) are as follows:

	Maximum yearly dose (rem)
1. Effective dose (equivalent)	5
2. Lens of eye	15
3. Skin or any extremity (hands and feet)	50

Based on the current dose limits, Table 1 should be revised as follows (using the same formula of 2.5 and 7.5%)
