Dear Mr. Murphy:

Reference is made to your letter of January 14, 1957, to Herman M. Roth, of this division, requesting instructions as to the disposition of nuclear scrap material which was supplied to you by the Air Force.

We have discussed this matter with S. J. Braiden and H. V. Werner, of the New York Operations Office, and have determined that since the scrap contains normal uranium, it would not be worth returning to Oak Ridge for disposal. If you will describe this material further to Mr. Braiden or Mr. Werner (concerning radioactivity or other specific problems) they will be able to advise you accordingly.

Please advise if we can be of further assistance in this matter.
