This is to acknowledge your letter of September 5. We shall be happy to have you visit us on the 20th to discuss any problems for disposal of radioactive waste which you have in mind.

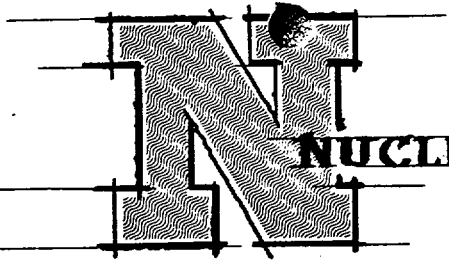
