Thank you for your e-mail and copy of the Department of Energy (DOE) letter. We were not aware of the DOE approval. The DOE letter indicates that Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) approval is also required for the transfer. Have you notified the NRC Research Reactor Division of the impending transfer?

Your e-mail indicated that you possessed the documentation package for the new fuel elements. We would like to have sufficient time to review this documentation prior to the new elements being shipped. This documentation should include warranty certificates, Ken Mushinski's inspection results, certified drawings and quality assurance papers.

Prior to shipment we also require copies of the NRC import and export licenses, the transport company's DOE/NRC license, and cask certification certificates.

Nuclear Materials Management & Safeguards System (NMMSS) reports will have to be completed at shipment and receipt. The university's Special Nuclear Material Representative is Mike Morlang. He can be reached at the same address and phone number provided above. Please have your NMMSS report specialist contact Mike as early as possible to ensure accurate and timely submission of all reports.

Your e-mail indicated that you would like to complete the transfer in the late May time frame. Both the SNM representative and myself will be unavailable the last week in May and the first week in June. The middle of June would fit our schedules better, if that were not too much of an inconvenience for you.
