FINAL SIGNIFICANCE DETERMINATION FOR THE FINDING ON SIREN PERFORMANCE

Reference: Letter from J. E. Dyer (NRC) to M. E. Reddemann (NMC) dated February 28, 2001

In the Reference, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) documented their assessment of the significance of the siren performance issues documented in inspection report 50-305/00-17. The Reference stated the Nuclear Management Company (NMC) had 10 working days to appeal the NRC's proposed finding. This letter documents a discussion between Mr. James Caldwell (NRC) and Mr. Mark Reddemann (NMC) held on March 12, 2001. During this discussion, Mr. Reddemann explained that NMC staff was having difficulty following the process the NRC used to obtain the Yellow Finding and requested additional time to respond. During this discussion, it was agreed that NMC could have 30 days from the date of the letter to respond to the finding.
