SUBJECT: ISSUANCE OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING SUMMARY REPORT  
ASSOCIATED WITH THE STAFF'S REVIEW OF THE APPLICATION BY  
FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY FOR RENEWAL OF THE  
OPERATING LICENCES FOR TURKEY POINT UNITS 3 AND 4

Dear Mr. Hovey:

From October 24 through December 22, 2000, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) conducted a scoping process to determine the scope of the NRC staff's environmental review of the application for renewal of the operating licenses for Turkey Point Units 3 and 4 (Turkey Point), submitted by Florida Power and Light Company in its letter dated September 8, 2000. As part of the scoping process, the NRC staff held two transcribed public environmental scoping meetings in Homestead, Florida, on December 6, 2000, to solicit public input regarding the scope of the review. During the scoping period, the staff also accepted written comments submitted by letter and via e-mail. The scoping process is the first step in the development of a plant-specific supplement to NUREG-1437, "Generic Environmental Impact Statement for License Renewal of Nuclear Plants (GEIS)," for Turkey Point.

The NRC staff has prepared the enclosed environmental scoping summary report identifying comments received at the December 6, 2000, license renewal environmental scoping meetings, and in writing during the comment period. In accordance with 10 CFR 51.29(b), you are being provided a copy of the scoping summary report. The transcripts of the meetings can be found at the NRC website, as attachments to the meeting summary dated January 10, 2001, at <http://www.nrc.gov/NRC/REACTOR/LR/TURKEYPOINT/docs.html>. The comment letters and e-mails are available electronically for public inspection in the NRC Public Document Room, from the Publicly Available Records (PARS) component of NRC's document system (ADAMS), or at the Homestead Branch Library, 700 N. Homestead Blvd., Homestead, Florida. ADAMS is accessible from the NRC Web site at <http://www.nrc.gov/NRC/ADAMS/index.html> (the Public Electronic Reading Room) (Note that the URLs are case-sensitive).
