

completion of this review. New receipt date for these comments was changed to 16 February 2001.

3. Army comments on the draft DP were received by SBCCOM on 06 February 2001. A telephonic response was received from the Air Force on 04 January 2001 and a memo dated 24 January 2001 with comments from the Fish and Wildlife Service. Comments from Army Medical Command, through the independent scientific review by the American Institute of Biological Sciences (AIBS), were received on 27 February 2001. Comments from the Agency for Toxic Substances Disease Registry (ATSDR) were received on 31 January 2001. Additionally, SBCCOM requested a review of the draft DP by the Oak Ridge Institute for Science and Education. Comments from this agency were received on 13 February 2001.
4. A Restoration Advisory Board (RAB) meeting for JPG was held on 06 February 2001 in Madison, Indiana. The RAB serves as a site-specific advisory board for JPG and meets periodically in the local area. The goal of the RAB is to ensure the concerns of the community are identified and addressed to the extent possible through public participation. JPG/SBCCOM is using the RAB as one means to provide for community participation and input on JPG license termination activities. The current DP Schedule and related activities were discussed at this RAB meeting.
5. In conjunction with the RAB meeting in February, a Public Summary of the efforts at JPG for this license amendment was prepared and mailed to all recipients on the mailing list on 08 January 2001. A notice of its availability was also published in two local newspapers, the Madison Courier and the Louisville Courier Journal, on 12, 15 and 17 January 2001. This summary is to provide a current status of where we are at, to solicit comments from the surrounding community for the RAB meeting, and to more adequately address the public involvement requirements for license termination. Questions or comments on this summary sheet and the termination efforts are being accepted through a variety of ways, to include in writing to the JPG Site Manager or the SBCCOM Radiation Safety Officer or through electronic email to the SBCCOM Radiation Safety Officer.
6. A copy of the draft DP was forwarded to Save the Valley (STV), via Federal Express, on 16 February 2001 and was received by STV on 20 February 2001.
7. At the request of STV, an additional 30 days is being provided for their review of the draft DP. The revised schedule is provided below with the current activity in bold.
