I. SECY-88-291A - Shoreham Exercise Hearing

The Commission,* by a 4-0 vote (with Chairman Zech and Commissioners Roberts, Carr, and Rogers agreeing), approved an order which establishes expedited procedures under which the Hearing on the 1988 emergency planning exercise for the Shoreham Nuclear Power Station would conclude in approximately five months with a decision in approximately seven months.

The Order also notes that although the Commission has under review the OL-3 Board's dismissal of the intervenors in LBP-88-24, the Commission believes it is prudent to establish procedures and go forward with any necessary proceeding on the 1988 exercise, at least pending the Commission decision on its review of LBP-88-24.

The matter of dismissal of intervenors as parties will be addressed by a separate order at a later date.

Commissioner Curtiss did not participate in this matter.
