This letter acknowledges receipt of your letter dated March 23, 2001, which transmitted changes to the Emergency Preparedness Plan for the Rhode Island Atomic Energy Commission research reactor submitted under the provisions of 10 CFR 50.54(q).

Based on a telephone conversation with you on March 28, 2001, NRC approval is not required since you stated that the changes do not decrease the effectiveness of the emergency plan. Our initial review of these changes indicates them to be in accordance with 10 CFR 50.54(q).
