In a letter dated December 5, 2001, the Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison), provided to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) changes to certain Technical Specifications (TSs) Bases sections for Indian Point Nuclear Generating Unit No. 2 (IP2). Specifically, Con Edison provided changes to the Bases for TS 2.3, "Limiting Safety System Settings, Protective Instrumentation," TS 3.3, "Engineered Safety Features," TS 3.6, "Containment Systems," and TS 4.5, "Engineered Safety Features." Con Edison stated that the changes were processed in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 50.59.
