## Administrative Judges:

By Order Approving Transfer of Licenses and Conforming Amendments dated March 9, 2001, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission consented to the transfer of Millstone Nuclear Power Station, Units 2 and 3 from Northeast Nuclear Energy Company and the colicensee selling owners to Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc., an indirectly, wholly-owned subsidiary of Dominion Energy which, in turn, is wholly-owned by Dominion Resources, Inc.<sup>1</sup> The Order was effective upon issuance, subject to the condition that should the transfer of licenses not be completed by March 9, 2002, the Order shall become null and void.

1 Dominion Nuclear Connecticut, Inc. will be the sole owner and operator of Millstone Unit 2 and will hold a 93.4707% ownership interest in Unit 3 and will be the operator on behalf of itself and Central Vermont Public Service Corporation which holds a 1.7303% interest and Massachusetts Municipal Wholesale Electric Company which holds a 4.7990% interest in Unit 3.
