WORKING GROUP TO ADDRESS SEP/DECOMMISSIONING ISSUES

- Past practice was <u>not</u> based on a solid technical understanding of the issues:
 - * too many assumptions drove the results
 - * too little test and analysis
 - * too little consideration of probability
 - * too little gradation of requirements
 - too little consideration of time for recovery
- Past practice probably resulted in very conservative decisions.
- Working group Tasks:
 - re-evaluate probability and consequences of SFP scenarios
 - re-evaluated fuel heat up analysis
 - add consideration of time for recovery
 - assess the read likelihood and consequences of zircaloy fires
 - how do they start?
 - how do they spread (of at all)?
 - re-evaluate fuel failure progression
 - re-evaluate transport mechanisms
 - compare probability and consequences of SFP scenarios to operating reactor probability and consequences
 - evaluate value and effectiveness of EP for SFP scenarios
 - evaluate some failed fuel and some not

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
