In a memo dated April 21, 1999 from Ashok Thadani to Jesse Funches, RES outlined its self-assessment initiatives for its 2001 budget, which involved a prioritization of activities.

Number 21 of the list was "Risk Analysis of Long-Term Storage," which would assess the risk of maintaining fuel in reactor SFPs in decommissioned plants, The work would support regulatory decision making (e.g., appropriate EP). 0.5 FTE and \$300K are designated for 2000 and 2001 for the project.

It sounds like the work is being planned or anticipated but not started.

Does the INEL work you are setting up have to go through RES? Are you aware of any PRA work being done?

I have checked with the decommissioning projects group and SPFO and they do not know of this activity. I have a call out to contacts in NMSS and RES with the same quesion.

It is very similar to (if not the exact same) work you/we are doing right now and it would be good to coordinate our agency efforts. If you have any ideas of who is the requesting office for the work, please let me know.
