The U. S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff has reviewed "2000 Annual Site Inspection and Monitoring Compliance Report for Title II Sites", dated October 3, 2000. Based on this review, we conclude that the inspections and the routine actions that are being performed are acceptable.

The staff notes that some minor erosion, ponding, and vegetation growth have been observed at the sites. Although none of these problems appear to be significant at this time, your continued observations of the problems are important.
