Condition number 11 of our license number 31-461-10 reads: "Byproduct material to be used by or under the supervision of Dr. Julian H. Webb, Radiological Safety Officer." For organizational purposes we would like to have this condition changed to read: "Byproduct material to be used by or under the control of Radiation Protection Committee, Eastman Kodak Company, Kodak Park, Dr. William L. Sutton, Secretary."

This is requested primarily to relieve Dr. Webb of correspondence concerning this license and the use of tritium buttons from states that have or will have radiation protection codes. Since active organizational radiation protection is conducted by the Laboratory of Industrial Medicine and is supervised particularly by Dr. William L. Sutton, this change seems indicated and appropriate.

Recently Mr. Kriegsman of the New York Operation Office, Inspection Division visited us. He informed me that it is the usual practice to assign one member of the division of licensing and regulation to a licensee. Are you so "assigned" to us?
