Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted on July 20, 1959 of your facilities authorized under AEC Inspection Material License No. 31-461-10.

It appears that certain of your activities were not conducted in full compliance with a condition of your license, in that the individual license engraving printed with certain-activated numbers print contained up to 100 millionaires of hydrogen 3 rather than 20 millionaires each. This constitutes a violation of License Condition No. 5C, "Maximum amount of radioactivity."

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2.501(a), "Notice of violation," of the AEC's "Rules of Practice," Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, you are requested to notify this office, within thirty days of your receipt of this notice, of the steps taken or to be instituted to achieve correction of the alleged violations, and the date when such correction has been or will be achieved.

If you wish, you may submit an application requesting that your license be amended authorizing the possession and use of license engravings containing up to 100 millionaires of hydrogen 3 each. Form AEC-313 are enclosed for this purpose.
