SUBJECT: FOLLOWUP REVIEW OF TERMINATED LICENSES

Dear Lt. Col. Swenson:

By letter dated September 26, 2000, we requested your assistance in the followup review of eight terminated licenses, including any relevant records or information which may exist in your files or institutional memory relating to radioactive material disposition and/or site decommissioning. Attached to that letter was copies of the eight license docket files.

The purpose of this letter is to transfer two additional license files to you for review in accordance with the information provided in our September 26, 2000, letter. The first license was issued to the Douglas Aircraft Company of Santa Monica, California. The license authorized the possession of depleted uranium. One location of use listed in the license was Eglin Air Force Base, Florida. The second license was issued to Ball Brothers Research Corporation of Boulder, Colorado, for possession of byproduct material in sealed source form. A location of use listed in this license was the Cape Kennedy Air Force Station, Florida. Copies of the two license docket files are enclosed to this letter.

These two files were recently transferred to the States of California and Colorado, respectively, for followup review. However, the NRC maintains responsibility for followup reviews of terminated licenses in areas of exclusive Federal jurisdiction within Agreement States. Accordingly, we are requesting your assistance only for the two Air Force Bases listed above and not the California and Colorado locations listed in the two respective licenses. Details of the two licenses were provided telephonically to Capt. David Pugh of your staff by Mr. Robert Evans of our staff on April 10, 2001.

The NRC's goal is to complete all reviews in the near future. Therefore, a timely review of the 10 license files would be appreciated to provide the NRC with time to review your records search results. Following our review, the NRC will coordinate with the Air Force any additional review effort or radiological surveys which may be necessary on a case by case basis.
