Dear Mr. Miller:

You are currently in arrears for Invoice No. E0014-99. In accordance with your agreement, this account should have been paid in full on November 21, 2000. The current amount due is \$135.70. You are requested to pay this amount in full within 15 days from the date of this letter. Failure to make payment within 15 days will result in your account being referred to the Department of the Treasury for collection. The Department of the Treasury is entitled to charge up to 34% depending upon who collects the debt for them. The Department of the Treasury has the authority to offset any tax refund, to refer your account to the Department of Justice for litigation, to administratively offset any payment made to you by the Federal government or by a state government and to refer your account to a private collection agency. As the debtor, you will be responsible for all fees incurred in collecting this debt.
