Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1946 and Section 40.21 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 10 - Atomic Energy, Chapter I, Part 40 - Control of Source Material, and in view of the representations made in your application for license, you are hereby authorized:

To receive possession of and title to not more than a quarter (1/4) pounds of uranium metal during the term of this license from processors and distributors licensed by the Atomic Energy Commission, for use in research and development.

(Applications for additional quantities during the term of this license should be filed on form AEC-8, in triplicate. A separate application must be made for each transaction in excess of the quantity here authorized.)

This license shall expire at 12:01 a. m., E. S. T., on May 1, 1951.
