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SUBJECT: CORRECTION OF "BIWEEKLY NOTICE APPLICATIONS AND AMENDMENTS TO OPERATING LICENSES INVOLVING NO SIGNIFICANT HAZARDS CONSIDERATIONS," AND CORRECTION TO AMENDMENT NO. 15, NINE MILE POINT NUCLEAR STATION UNIT NO. 2 (TAC NOS. 74755 AND 75302)

On May 13, 1990 we issued Amendment No. 15 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-69 for the Nine Mile Point Nuclear Station Unit No. 2 (NMP-2) on main stream tunnel temperatures (TAC No. 74755). The "Notice of Issuance of Amendment to Facility Operating License" was published on May 30, 1990 (55 FR 21985) as part of the subject biweekly notice and contained two errors. The Docket No. 50-220 should be corrected to read Docket No. 50-410 and Unit No. 1 should be corrected to read Unit No. 2.

Also included as part of the subject biweekly notice under the heading "Notice of Consideration of Issuance of Amendments to Facility Operating License and Proposed No Significant Hazards," was a notice related to your submittals of November 17, 1989 and April 26, 1990 on NMP-2 snubber surveillance requirements (TAC No. 75302). This notice contained a publishing error. The statement in quotes "(18 months 27 25)" should be corrected to read "(18 months plus or minus 25%)."

A copy of the "Correction Notice" is enclosed. This notice has been forwarded to the Office of the Federal Register for publication.

In addition to the above described errors, we are enclosing a signed copy of the Amendment that was issued as part of Amendment No. 15. Due to an administrative error, this Amendment was dispatched without the necessary signature on the second page of the document.

We apologize for any inconvenience these errors may have caused.

AMENDMENT TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

Amendment No. 15  
License No. NPF-69

1. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission (the Commission) has found that:
  - A. The application for amendment by Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation (the licensee) dated August 17, 1989, complies with the standards and requirements of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended (the Act) and the Commission's rules and regulations set forth in 10 CFR Chapter I;
  - B. The facility will operate in conformity with the application, the provisions of the Act, and the rules and regulations of the Commission;
  - C. There is reasonable assurance (i) that the activities authorized by this amendment can be conducted without endangering the health and safety of the public, and (ii) that such activities will be conducted in compliance with the Commission's regulations;
  - D. The issuance of this amendment will not be inimical to the common defense and security or to the health and safety of the public; and
  - E. The issuance of this amendment is in accordance with 10 CFR Part 51 of the Commission's regulations and all applicable requirements have been satisfied.
2. Accordingly, the license is amended by changes to the Technical Specifications as indicated in the attachment to this license amendment, and paragraph 2.C.(2) of Facility Operating License No. NPF-69 is hereby amended to read as follows:

(2) Technical Specifications and Environmental Protection Plan

The Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A and the Environmental Protection Plan contained in Appendix B, both of which are attached hereto, as revised through Amendment No. 15 are hereby incorporated into this license. Niagara Mohawk Power Corporation shall operate the facility in accordance with the Technical Specifications and the Environmental Protection Plan.

3. This license amendment is effective as of the date of its issuance to be implemented within 30 days.
