NOTICE OF PROPOSED ISSUANCE OF AMENDMENT
TO FACILITY OPERATING LICENSE

The Atomic Energy Commission (the Commission) is considering the issuance of an amendment to Facility Operating License No. DPR-16 issued to Jersey Central Power & Light Company (the licensee) for operation of the Oyster Creek Nuclear Generating Station (the facility), a boiling water reactor located in Lacey Township, Ocean County, New Jersey, and currently authorized for operation at power levels up to 1930 Mwt.

The license amendment would revise the Technical Specifications for the facility to incorporate increased interim surveillance requirements for the high energy fluid piping outside containment pending completion and acceptance of certain modifications to the facility to assure that it will withstand the consequences of postulated ruptures in the high energy fluid piping outside containment without loss of capability to achieve and maintain safe shutdown of the facility as required by the Commission's regulations.

By November 6, 1974 , the licensee may file a request for a hearing and any person whose interest may be affected by this proceeding may file a petition for leave to intervene. Requests for a hearing and petitions for leave to intervene shall be filed in accordance with the Commission's "Rules of Practice" in 10 CFR Part 2 (Section 2.714). If a

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request for a hearing or petition for leave to intervene is filed within the time prescribed in this notice, the Commission will issue a notice of hearing or an appropriate order.

For further details with respect to this action, see the Commission's letters to the licensee dated December 18, 1972, and the licensee's report on pipe failures dated July 1, 1974. These documents are available for public inspection at the Commission's Public Document Room, 1717 H Street, N. W., Washington, D. C., and at the Ocean County Library, 15 Hooper Avenue, Toms River, New Jersey. As the Safety Evaluation Report to be prepared by the Directorate of Licensing on the subject of pipe failures and the license amendment become available, they may be inspected at the above locations and a copy of each may be obtained upon request addressed to the U. S. Atomic Energy Commission, Washington, D. C. 20545, Attention: Deputy Director for Reactor Projects, Directorate of Licensing - Regulation.
