Gentlemen:

Your letter dated April 19, 1972, submitted Facility Change Request No. 3 that described and evaluated a change in the cycle 2 reload for the Oyster Creek reactor. This change involved substituting four fuel bundles (Type III), designed and manufactured by the Jersey Nuclear Corporation, for four of the General Electric Type II fuel bundles of the cycle 2 reload as described in Facility Change Request No. 2.

We have reviewed Change Request No. 3 and we have concluded that the proposed loading of the Type III fuel bundles does not present significant hazards considerations not described or implicit in the Safety Analysis Report and that there is reasonable assurance that the health and safety of the public will not be endangered by the loading of the four Type III fuel bundles as described.

Accordingly, pursuant to 10 CFR 50.59, you are hereby authorized to load the four Type III Reload Fuel bundles in the configuration described in Facility Change Request No. 3.

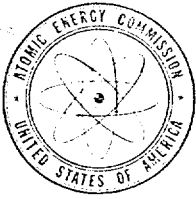
