On April 8, 2001, at 1930 hours, the Meterological Site Number One 10-Meter Termperature Element (ITE08501) was declared inoperable. The equipment was taken out of service due to excessive signal noise. Extensive troubleshooting determined that the signal noise was caused by a grounding problem.

The equipment remains out of service. An investigation is currently being done by the vendor to determine the proper repair of the equipment. Maintenance personnel hope to have the equipment operable by April 27, 2001.
