SUBJECT: Lead-210 Exceedances, TAC L52350	
<p>SUMMARY: An Earth Tech, Inc.letter, dated April 2, 2001, requested that the NRC delete the requirement for lead-210 from the Church Rock, New Mexico, site standards on the basis that the level of lead-210 in the groundwater is below detection limits. The data provided in the letter appears to justify this position, but does not include the analysis results for the QA/QC blanks. I called Ms. DuPont to inform her that although an acceptance review of the data had been performed, no further action could be completed until receipt of the analyses of the blanks to clearly indicate the analytical variation in the detection method. She agreed to submit the data for the blanks in the next week or two.</p>
