Dear Mr. Ignatonis

In response to your letter of February 6, 1998 related to Discrimination Complaint RII-1998-A-0012, I replied on February 13, 1998. To date I have not had an acknowledgement or received a status on my concerns. If you did not receive my February 13 letter, please advise me and I will re-send the letter. As I stated in my February 13 letter, most of my office notes and stuff are still in storage and I would inform you of addition items I discovered while cleaning out my history files. Well, I still have my stuff in storage, however, I did think of an additional concern that is addressed below. I would like to be kept informed of the status of my concerns when information is available.

Another area of concern I had while I was [REDACTED] instance that too many things were being written up in the Condition Report process. When other processes such as Engineering Service Requests, (ESRs) are utilized the required review for operability and reportability is not completed. It was my unpopular opinion that the emphasis on avoiding the CR process allowed significant issues to given a low priority or even cancelled. A few examples of my concern are listed below. 
