3 CHAIRMAN MESERVE: Good morning. We have
4 two affirmation matters to deal with first.

5 Mr. Secretary, you may proceed.

6 ACTING SECRETARY BATES: Mr. Chairman,
7 Commissioners, the first item this morning deals with
8 Millstone. The Commission is being asked to act on a
9 memorandum, an order related to the partial review of
10 ELP 0026, as directed by the Commission's memorandum
11 and order in CLI-0103 regarding the interpretation of
12 general design criteria 62, the prevention of
13 criticality in fuel storage and handling.

14 The Commission has voted to approve an
15 order and memorandum which affirms the Licensing
16 Board's decision in favor of Northeast Nuclear Energy
17 Company. The general design criteria 62 permits a
18 licensee to use administrative controls to implement
19 physical criticality prevention systems.

20 Would you affirm your votes?

21 (Unanimous.)

22 The second matter deals with Sharon
23 Harris. The Commission is being asked to act on a
24 memorandum and order responding to Orange County's
25 petition for review of a series of Licensing Board

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1 decisions approving a license amendment filed by
2 Carolina Power and Light to increase spent fuel
3 storage capacity at its Sharon Harris Nuclear Power
4 Plant.

5 In addition, Orange County filed an
6 emergency motion for a stay of LBP 0109, pending
7 disposition of their review. The Commission has voted
8 to approve a memorandum and order which denies Orange
9 County's petition for review of the Board rulings in
10 LBP 0012, 0019, and 0109, and denies Orange County's
11 request for an emergency stay of LBP 0109.

12 Would you affirm your votes, please?
