Accordingly, I confirm that these activities do not fall under the export licensing authority of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission.

To the extent that the Institute's activities involve the transfer of nuclear-related information and technology to foreign entities, I suggest you also confirm with the U.S. Department of Energy that such transfers do not require specific authorization by the Department of Energy pursuant to its nuclear technology export controls as specified in 10 CFR Part 810.
