On April 2, 2001, the NRC issued Regulatory Issue Summary 2001-08, "Operating Reactor Licensing Action Estimates," which requested that licensees submit information pertaining to estimates of the number of licensing actions that will be submitted for NRC review for the remainder of Fiscal Year (FY) 2001 and for FY 2002. With regard to the Joseph M. Farley Nuclear Plant, Southern Nuclear Operating Company estimates that nine (9) submittals will be made during the remainder of FY 2001 and that ten (10) submittals will be made during FY 2002. It is not anticipated that any of the planned submittals will generate a complex review.
