SUBJECT: SUPPLEMENT 1 TO NUREG-0737, REQUEST FOR MODIFICATION OF COMMISSION ORDER DATED JUNE 14, 1984.

Re: Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, Units Nos. 2 and 3

By letter dated January 7, 1985, you requested that we extend the completion date for one item contained in the Commission Orders dated June 14, 1984. Specifically you requested an extension in the date for completion of the Detailed Control Room Design Review (DCRDR) Summary Report from March 15, 1985 to June 30, 1985. You stated that the revised schedule was necessary to more completely address the task of resolving human factor concerns with the more than ten years of Peach Bottom operating experience, to further resolve difficulties in obtaining technical agreement among the variety of disciplines involved in the review and, finally, to reassess the original program plan based upon recent NRC clarifications in response to the BWR Owners' Group CRDR Committee.

We agree that the above issues and tasks should be further considered and factored into your summary report. Therefore, in accordance with the terms of the June 14, 1984 Commission Order, we conclude that there is adequate justification for modification of the Commission's Order and hereby grant the requested delay. The completion date shown in the June 14, 1984 Orders for submittal of the DCRDR Summary Report is extended to June 30, 1985.
