Dear Mr. Bauer:

The Commission has issued the enclosed Amendments Nos. 101 and 103, to Facility Operating Licenses Nos. DPR-44 and DPR-56 for the Peach Bottom Atomic Power Station, Units Nos. 2 and 3. These amendments consist of changes to the Technical Specifications (TSs) in response to your application dated March 24, 1981, as supplemented by letters dated August 6, 1981, December 13, 1982, June 22, 1983, September 14, 1983 and January 26, 1984.

The changes to the TSs revise the testing requirements for hydraulic shock suppressors (snubbers), add new requirements for mechanical snubber operability and testing, and add new references to Table 3.11.D.1 to reflect recent Peach Bottom modifications. These changes to the TSs also permit a one-time relief from the functional testing of mechanical snubbers. This one-time relief is granted until the first refueling outage commencing one year after NRC approval of this amendment.

A copy of the Safety Evaluation is also enclosed. Notice of Issuance will be included in the Commission's next monthly Federal Register notice.
