

As requested (Reference a), we are providing information concerning the number and complexity of licensing issues that we anticipate sending to the Nuclear Regulatory Commission in the next two years. We plan to submit 16 new licensing actions in the remainder of fiscal year 2001. None of these actions have been identified as requiring complex reviews. In addition, we currently have 8 new licensing actions identified for submittal during fiscal year 2002. We would anticipate that number could grow to about 20 over the next year. Again, none of these actions have been identified as requiring complex reviews.
