Dear Ms. Schossow:

This confirms the verbal authorization provided on May 2, 2001, to start work under this task order with a temporary ceiling of \$20,000. Therefore, in accordance with the task order procedures of the subject contract, this letter definitizes Task Order No. 4. This effort shall be performed in accordance with the enclosed Statement of Work and the Contractor's technical proposal dated April 25, 2001, with revisions dated May 1, 2001, which is incorporated by reference and made a part of this task order. Task Order No. 4 shall be in effect from May 2, 2001 through September 14, 2001 with a cost ceiling of \$148,933. The amount of \$136,636 represents the total estimated reimbursable costs, and the amount of \$12,297 represents the fixed fee for this task order.

The amount obligated on this task order document is \$120,000 (inclusive of the \$20,000 authorized verbally on 5/2/01). Of this amount \$110,092 represents the estimated costs and \$9,908 represents the fixed fee. The obligated amount shall, at no time, exceed the task order ceiling. When and if the amount(s) paid and payable to the Contractor hereunder shall equal the obligated amount, the Contractor shall not be obligated to continue performance of the work unless and until the Contracting Officer shall increase the amount obligated with respect to this task order. Any work undertaken by the Contractor in excess of the obligated amount specified above is done so at the Contractor's sole risk.
