MEMORANDUM AND ORDER  
(Extending Date for  
Submitting Proposed  
Protective Order)

In the Licensing Board's February 24, 1999 initial prehearing order, we provided that any request for a protective order in connection with a proprietary portion of the December 23, 1998 Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) amendment application at issue in this proceeding should be submitted by March 4, 1999. See Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Feb. 24, 1999) at 3 n.1 (unpublished). In a telephone conference yesterday with the Board Chairman, counsel for CP&L and for petitioner Board of Commissioners of Orange County, North Carolina, (BCOC) indicated that arrangements were being made to provide the proprietary material to BCOC by the beginning of next week for review to decide if any proprietary portions would need to be included

as part of BCOC's contentions. Counsel suggested that the date for requesting a protective order be extended to permit a determination about whether such an order would be necessary. NRC staff counsel, who also participated in the telephone conference, indicated she had no objection to this request.


The BCOC request to extend the date for filing a protective order motion is granted. Any motion for a protective order regarding Enclosure 7 to the CP&L application shall be filed on or before Friday, March 19, 1999. The request should include a proposed order and a statement indicating the position of the other participants with respect to the motion.

The filings permitted under this memorandum and order should be served on the Board, the Office of the Secretary, and counsel for the other participants by facsimile transmission, e-mail, or other means that will ensure receipt by midnight Eastern Time (ET) on the day of filing.


