<u>MEMORANDUM AND ORDER</u> (Transcript Corrections and Proposed Restatement of Contention 3)

Any participant wishing to propose corrections to the transcript of the May 13, 1999 prehearing conference should do so on or before <u>Thursday, May 27, 1999</u>. <u>See</u> 10 C.F.R. § 2.750(b). Objections to any proposed transcript corrections shall be filed on or before <u>Friday, June 4, 1999</u>.

In addition, in its May 5, 1999 response to the contentions of petitioner Board of Commissioners of Orange County, North Carolina, (BCOC) applicant Carolina Power & Light Company (CP&L) proposed a restatement of Contention 3. <u>See</u> Applicant's Answer to Petitioner [BCOC's] Contentions (May 5, 1999) at 36-37. On or before <u>Friday, May 28, 1999</u>, petitioner BCOC should advise the Board if it has any

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objections to that restatement. The participants are encouraged to reach agreement on contention language whenever possible. To this end, BCOC should discuss and attempt to resolve any concerns it may have about the restated contention with CP&L and the NRC staff.

The filings required or permitted under this memorandum and order should be served on the Board, the Office of the Secretary, and counsel for the other participants by facsimile transmission, e-mail, or other means that will ensure receipt by midnight Eastern Time (ET) on the day of filing. <u>See</u> Licensing Board Memorandum and Order (Initial Prehearing Order) (Feb. 24, 1998) at 9 (unpublished).
