Franklin Street, Chapel Hill, North Carolina,</u> <u>beginning at 9:30 a.m. on Thursday, May 13, 1999</u>. If necessary, the prehearing conference will continue on Friday, May 14, 1999, at the same location.

During the initial prehearing conference, the Licensing Board will hear arguments from the participants on the issues of BCOC's standing and the admissibility of the contentions BCOC has submitted.

If BCOC subsequently is found to have standing and to have submitted one or more litigable contentions, the Board will issue a notice of hearing that, in accordance with 10 C.F.R. § 2.715(a), will afford members of the public an opportunity to provide written or, as appropriate, oral limited appearance statements on the issues. The Board will issue a further notice outlining the times, places, and
