**COOPERATION WITH MEXICO** 

The Commission has approved the staff recommendations for assistance activities with the Mexican nuclear regulatory and research authorities, as described in COMSECY-99-035. This includes:

- 1. Hold further discussions with Comision Nacional de Seguridad Nuclear y Salvaguardias (CNSNS) on communication needs in November 2000.
- 2. Offer membership in the Office of Nuclear Regulatory Research (RES) International Code Applications and Maintenance Program (CAMP) and Cooperative Severe Accident Research Program (CSARP) to Mexico at a reduced rate of \$25,000 per year for each program for in-kind technical contributions.
- 3. Offer to have two individuals travel to Mexico to observe and comment during the next emergency exercise at Laguna Verde.
- 4. Offices of International Programs (OIP) and RES develop implementing agreements to the existing NRC-CNSNS Arrangement to address cooperation in emergency preparedness and participation in the international cooperative research programs.
