Subject: Revision to Response to Notices of Violation Contained in Inspection Report
50-461/98009 (DRS)

This letter provides notification of a change to a commitment contained in the Clinton Power Station response to Notice of Violation (NOV) 98009-05. Our original response to this NOV contained in Letter U-603058 dated August 5, 1998, contained the following commitment:

- "Emergency Planning will conduct at least one after hours drill per year which will specify that ERO personnel will need to use their ERO badges to gain access to the protected area."

Since the time of this response, CPS has determined that the need for ERO members to carry an ERO Badge is unnecessary and this procedural requirement will be eliminated. In addition, CPS will be conducting future after hours drills in accordance with the frequency requirements specified in NUREG-0654 / FEMA-REP-1, Revision 1. Since the response to NOV 98009-05, CPS has conducted after hours drills on an increased frequency (approximately annually) and ERO member response has been favorable. Based on the elimination of the ERO badges and the favorable ERO member response to the after hours drills, CPS has determined that the need to perform annual after hours drills is not necessary and will perform the drills per the frequency requirements specified in NUREG-0654 / FEMA-REP-1, Revision 1.
