In response to your question concerning what is meant by early fatality:

The fatalities that result from substantial radiation exposures incurred during short time periods are termed early fatalities. There are three types of early health effects that result in fatality: hematopoietic syndrome, pulmonary syndrome, and gastro-intestinal syndrome.

Doses received after 30 days do not contribute to hematopoietic syndrome.

Doses received after 365 days do not contribute to pulmonary syndrome.

Doses received after 7 days do not contribute to gastro-intestinal syndrome.
