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

RESCISSION OF ORDER

On August 16, 1985, the Director of the Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation issued an "Order Suspending Operation Above 5 Percent Power" applicable to the Limerick Generating Station, Unit 1. The Order was based on a stay issued on August 15, 1985, by the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. The court stayed the Commission's Order of August 8, 1985, which authorized issuance of a full power license, License No. NPF-39, for Limerick Unit 1. The Director's Order suspended operation of the facility above 5% of rated power to effectuate the court's stay of operations under the new license. The Director's Order stated that the suspension of operation above 5% of rated power would be rescinded upon action by the court to lift its stay.

On August 21, 1985, the court lifted its stay. Accordingly, the "Order Suspending Operation Above 5 Percent Power" issued by the Director of Nuclear Reactor Regulation on August 16, 1985, is hereby rescinded.
