SUBJECT: INCREASE IN SPRAY POND LEVEL (TAC NO. 69855)

RE: LIMERICK GENERATING STATION, UNIT 1

My letter of June 16, 1989 transmitted Amendment No. 25 to Facility Operating License No. NPF-39 for the Limerick Generating Station, Unit 1. The amendment changed page 3/4 7-5 of the Unit 1 Technical Specifications to increase the minimum level of water that must be maintained in the spray pond to support operation of two units. When only Unit 1 was operating, a lower level in the spray pond was acceptable. The revision to page 3/4 7-5 should have deleted the parenthetical note "(single unit operation)" since it is no longer applicable. A corrected page 3/4 7-5 and overleaf page 3/4 7-6 are enclosed.
